Dear Sir:

Inasmuch as you have conveyed to Fort Frederica Association properties described in the deed as of this date you have the right to occupy the premises thereby conveyed until January 1, 1944, and to raze, remove and salvage, at your own expense, materials of the buildings situated on the premises, provided, that if said buildings are not razed and removed on or before January 1, 1944, this reservation shall automatically become null and void, unless an extension of time for occupancy of the premises and removal of the buildings is granted by the undersigned.
